Membership Terms & Conditions

Club Membership is conditional to the terms and conditions set out below and with the clubs Rules and Information Sheet for the 2016 - 2017 season together with the members constitution, copies of which are available on request.

The Rayleigh Club Limited ("TRC") is a proprietary owned golf club, except where expressly agreed otherwise by us in writing every member of the club shall be subject to these terms and conditions.

Acceptance of an application by TRC constitutes a contract of membership of the club between TRC and the applicant/s subject to these terms and conditions.

TRC retain absolute discretion in accepting or rejecting any application without prejudice or ascribing any reason for so doing.

Membership entitlement

5 Day East members may play the East Course at any time Monday to Friday.

5 Day South members may play the South Course or the East Course at any time Monday to Friday.

5 Day South Restricted members may play the South Course or the East Course after 1pm Monday to Friday.

7 Day South members may play the South Course or the East Course at any time.

7 Day South Special Service members may play the South Course or the East Course at any time.

7 Day East Cadets may play the East Course at any time.

7 Day South Cadets may play the South Course at any time Monday to Friday and after 12pm at weekends.

Joint applicants must reside permanently at the same address.

Special services are limited to Army, Police, Ambulance, Fire and Coastguard services.

Members receiving a discount due to their age must provide adequate proof by way of a valid passport or driving license.

Members of the club will be provided with a membership card and bag tag, which will remain the property of TRC and must be returned to the club on cessation or suspension of membership.

A small charge may be levied should a replacement card or bag tag be required for any reason. Entry to the premises and golf course may be denied in the absence of these forms of membership identity, lost cards should be reported immediately to the club reception.

All members shall keep TRC up to date with any changes in personal details, including address, telephone numbers etc. with all changes being provided in writing. The clubs preference for contact is email, members without email access may not receive notices.

Members are entitled to use the facilities of the club available under the relevant category of membership. TRC reserve the right to withdraw all or any part of such facilities on a temporary or permanent basis when such facilities are required to be closed for inclement weather, repair, maintenance, development or alteration work. Members and their guests use all facilities at their own risk.

The course will be open for play from 7.00am or first light, whichever is the later, until dusk subject to weather and ground conditions.

The Proprietor may at his discretion close the course for annual maintenance for up to 5 days in each year.

Buggies, electric and pull trolleys are permitted for use but may be banned from time to time in accordance with assessment of ground conditions and the guidelines set out by the Head Greenkeeper.

All golfers must check in before play and are advised to arrive at least ten minutes ahead of their start time. Whilst every effort will be made to accommodate late arrivals, it may not be possible to gain access to the course if times are unavailable.

The rules of the game of golf adapted from time to time by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews shall apply to play at TRC. TRC shall set the standards of dress and etiquette for both the course(s) and Clubhouse

The Rayleigh Club reserve the right to refuse admission or cancel membership immediately if any member shall in the opinion of the management team on duty cause nuisance or annoyance to other club users or club staff. In the event of cancellation of membership, membership shall not be refunded.

Any member who is in material or persistent breach of the Constitution or Club Rules shall be liable to have all their rights of membership suspended by TRC for such time it considers appropriate. In the event of a continual breach of competition rules or inappropriate behaviour during Club Competitions or whilst representing the Club, the Club Committee may suspend any member for a period of time from these events, the secretary advising TRC of such action. A suspended member shall be given the right of representation and an explanation prior to any imposed suspension.

TRC may expel from the Club any member whose conduct, is injurious to the character, goodwill or interests of The Club or renders the member unfit to be associated with members of the Club. If the Club Committee so requires in relation to any member, TRC shall investigate the behaviour, in conjunction with the club committee of any member and consider whether that member shall be expelled from the Club. The club committee must not act in anyway by themselves which might prejudice the company or cause it financial loss. An expelled member shall forfeit all rights of the membership category, a proportion of the remaining term may be refunded.

Membership Terms & Conditions Continued

Guests may be introduced by members of the club subject to the approval of club staff. Guests must be accompanied by the member at all times, be signed in and pay the appropriate guest fee. The member will assume responsibility for ensuring that guests abide by club rules and codes of behaviour.

Members may sign in up to three guests per day subject to payment of the appropriate green fee prior to the commencement of the round. No one person may be signed in as a guest on more than four occasions per annum. A member whose guest plays without the payment of a green fee on the day shall be reprimanded and the guest shall be barred. Members guest rates shall be set by TRC and subject to change from time to time. Members may introduce guests to the Clubhouse facilities at no charge.

With the exception of guide dogs or hearing dogs for the deaf, pets should not be brought on to the golf course.

All members and guests must enter the premises at the appropriate entrance point only. Members should make themselves aware of appropriate emergency exit points and procedures and be prepared to use these in the event of an emergency.

The club cannot accept liability for members' cars, the contents of vehicles or other property, which are brought to the club at the member's, own risk. TRC's liability for damage or loss of members and guests' property is strictly limited to any damage or loss caused directly as a result of the negligence of TRC, its staff or agents. Any item of lost/found property unclaimed for a period greater than 3 months may be disposed of.

Any member or guest who suffers an accident on club premises or grounds must report the circumstances and details of the accident/incident to the senior staff member on duty immediately. TRC cannot accept any liability for any accident to a member or guest other than liability that may arise from the negligence of TRC.

The member is financially liable to TRC for annual membership fees and any goods and services used at the club from time to time. TRC shall not be responsible for damage, injury or loss occurring as a result of an act or omission of any member or visitor to TRC. A member or visitor shall indemnify TRC against any such liability. Any member or visitor who makes use or accepts use of any facility or service at TRC shall do so at their own risk, provided that TRC is not proved negligent in its provision. TRC cannot be held responsible for any loss of play due to inclement weather conditions resulting in course closures.

The membership year begins on April 1 and subscriptions are paid annually in advance. A member joins each year for a minimum period of one year unless he joins partway through a year in which case the member is responsible for his/her subscription up to the end of the yearly period unless otherwise agreed by TRC.

In the event a Member or the Club cancels a membership for any reason outside of our terms and conditions, a former member wishing to re-join must first pay any fees outstanding. Any former member that has not complied with this may not be signed in at guest rate, he is not allowed to play in any Open competition, He is not restricted from representing another club in a team match.

A member should write or email to inform us that he no longer wishes to continue his membership giving a minimum of 28 days notice.

TRC whose decision shall be final and binding shall determine any dispute which may arise in regard to interpretation of these rules.

The Rayleigh Club reserves the right to amend the rules at any time, notifying such change on the club notice board. Individual notice to members will not be required.

Management of the club and facilities is controlled by TRC who require members and guests to comply with any reasonable directions given to ensure the smooth operation of the club.
