

Rules & Regulations

1. **DRESS CODE**
All players must strictly adhere to the dress code as published on the notice board. Players will strictly observe the etiquette as laid down in the **rules of golf** section 1.
2. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
 - a) Beyond hedges & fences bounding the course and as marked by white posts, 1st, 4th and 5th posts to the left, 14th and 15th posts to the right.
 - b) A ball crossing the fence between the East and South course and coming to rest on the South course is out of bounds.
3. **WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**
Yellow and red stakes define the margins of water hazards and lateral water hazards respectively.
4. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)**
Staked trees, pylons, notice boards, fixed sprinkler heads, paths including buggy paths and the bridges. Also the blue 150yd marker posts. (Rule 24-1) Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.
5. **WIRES & CABLES**
If a ball strikes an elevated power line, the stroke must be cancelled and replayed without penalty. A ball striking a pylon must be played as it lies unless relief is appropriate. (Rule 24-2).
6. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR**
"GUR" (Rule 25-1) Relief without penalty may be taken. See notice board for current information.
7. **DRAINAGE CHANNELS**
Drainage channels and indentations caused by drainage (e.g. those near bunkers) are, "through the green," defined as Ground Under Repair.
8. **BALLS PLUGGED**
"Through the green", a ball that is embedded in its own pitch mark, may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay, but not nearer the hole.
9. **PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES**
Match Play - Loss of Hole;
Stroke Play - Two Strokes
10. **A MAXIMUM OF 4 PLAYERS PER MATCH (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

Notes: When in operation, pick, wipe and place is restricted to within 6 inches of where the ball lies, no nearer the hole, and on fairways and fringes of putting greens only.
